The author entry gives the name of the author(s) or principal author, if more than three; and the full title of the book. The reference is to the issue and page number, followed by the name of the reviewer. B.N. indicates Book Notes.

The title entry gives abbreviated title, except in the case of books without authors which are indexed in full; and the reference to the issue and the page where the book is reviewed. Series are included in the title sequence. There is a separate alphabetical index to reviewers with issue and page number.

Where an article was an overview without clear author and title details this is not indexed. Re-issues are generally not included. Periodicals are excluded.
