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COMPILER'S NOTE:

This index to The Australian Book Review issues 38-47 covers the period from February 1982 to January 1983. Number 38 covers two months, February and March 1982, and Number 47 the two months December 1982 and January 1983; the other issues are monthly.

The first index for issues 1 to 10 was published in The Australian Book Review issue 12, July 1979; the index for issues 11-37 was published in 1982 by Footscray Institute of Technology Library and is available from Bennetts - 4 Collaroy Street COLLAROY NSW 2097 price \$15.00.

Books reviewed are listed alphabetically in separate author and title sequences.

The author entry gives the name of the author(s) and full title of the book. The reference is to the issue and page number, followed by the name of the reviewer.

The title entry gives abbreviated title, except in the case of books without authors which are indexed by title in full; and the reference to the issue and the page where the book is reviewed.

There is a separate alphabetical index to reviewers with issue and page number. The reviewers of Book Notes are included when known.

Where an article was an overview without clear author and title details this is not indexed. Reissues are not generally included and periodicals are excluded.
