The Journal of Psychotherapy Practice and Research INFORMATION FOR CONTRIBUTORS

The Journal of Psychotherapy Practice and Research is a peer-reviewed interdisciplinary journal published quarterly by the American Psychiatric Association. Its aim is to advance the professional understanding of human behavior and to enhance the psychotherapeutic treatment of mental disorders. The Journal publishes review articles; original clinical, research, and educational articles; grand rounds; book reviews; and letters. The editors welcome contributions of original manuscripts that are not under consideration elsewhere. Upon acceptance of an article, the author(s) will be asked to supply a diskette of the manuscript and required to assign copyright ownership in writing to the American Psychiatric Association.

Peer Review: All manuscripts, including those written at the invitation of the editors, are subject to blind peer review to determine the originality, validity, and significance of the submitted material. Reviewers of manuscripts will be blind to the authors' identity and authors will be sent reviewer comments that are judged to be useful to them.

Manuscript Specifications: Manuscripts must be typed double-spaced with one-inch margins on plain bond paper. Draft-quality dot matrix printouts will be returned unreviewed. The cover page must contain the article title, authors' names and affiliations, and address for correspondence and telephone number of corresponding author. Anything identifying the author or the institution where the work was done should be removed from the remainder of the manuscript in order to protect the "blind." Each article must include an abstract (100-word maximum), keywords for indexing, and a reference list. Reference are numbered and listed by their order of appearance in text; text citation is followed by the appropriate reference number in curly brackets. Do not arrange the reference list alphabetically. Authors should be sure that all references listed have been cited in the text. Personal communications, unpublished manuscripts, manuscripts submitted but not yet accepted, and similar unpublished items should not appear in the reference list. Such citations may be noted in the text. List only the first three authors in the reference list and designate one or more authors past the third as "et al." Journal names should be abbreviated as they appear in Index Medicus; journals not currently indexed there should not be abbreviated. Please refer to the Journal's fourpage unabridged Information for Contributors for specific requirements regarding article types, style, research design and statistics, and tabular or graphical presentation of results. Submission Procedure: The original manuscript and four copies should be submitted to Jerald Kay, M.D., Editor, *The Journal of Psychotherapy Practice and Research*, 1400 K Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20005. Submissions should be accompanied by a cover letter indicating that the paper is intended for publication and specifying for which section of the journal it is being submitted (Special or Regular Articles, Clinical/Research Reports, Grand Rounds, Book Reviews, or Letters to the Editor). Books to be considered for review should be sent to Walter N. Stone, M.D., Book Review Editor, at the Journal address. Anyone wishing to review books for the Journal should apply to Dr. Stone at the same address.
