
## Second World Indigenous Youth Conference

This letter is to let you know organisation is underway for the Second World Indigenous Youth Conference, to be held in Darwin, from the 5 - 11 July, 1993. The event is expected to attract more than two thousand Indigenous Youth and Elders from around Australia and the world.

The theme for this gathering is "Claiming Our Future: the reality of where we are, and where we are going". It will be the first time the world's Indigenous Youth and Elders meet in Australia, to perform the corroboree of survival.

We, as youth, are aware of our responsibilities as the leaders of the future. However, we must seek the guidance and wisdom of our Leaders and Elders, as is our custom as descendants of the world's first nations.

To this end, we as Aboriginal youth invite you, as one of our Leaders, to speak at the Second World Indigenous Youth Conference: to communicate your knowledge of indigenous peoples' rights, as they apply to education and health, specifically to young Indigenous people.

The Organising Committee would like a response, at the earliest possible opportunity, on whether you are able to speak at the Conference. If so, please outline your requirements, in relation to accommodation, travel and so on.
