please find enclosed a short story, entitled "Anything That Flickers", which I submit to be considered for publication.

I am a 22-year-old graduate (with 1st class Honours) from the Department of Fine Arts at Sydney University. I have been working as a freelance journalist for almost one year, and have had three full-length feature articles (2,000-3,000 words) published by *Australian Style* magazine, and two 400 word 'gallery' reviews commissioned and published by *Black+ White* magazine.

I am a past editor of *Honi Soit*, the Sydney University student newspaper, and had one story and one poem published in last year's edition of *Hermes*, the annual literary magazine sponsored by Sydney University's Union.

Regardless of whether you judge it suitable for publication, I would genuinely appreciate your criticism.
